TRIAL DAY 1

1. Remarks/Remarques:

- a. Prosecution Counsel (Ms. Sylvana Arbia) made her opening statement from 9:00 to 9:30 a.m., followed by a brief statement by Defence Co-Counsel (Mr. Hooper).
- b. Prosecution Witness, Rajesh Neupane (PW1) entered the Courtroom and made the solemn declaration.
- c. Prosecution Counsel (Mr. Kapaya) examined Witness Rajesh Neupane from 9:35 to 11:42 a.m. in open session with an adjournment from 11:00 to 11:30 a.m.
- d. Defence Co-Counsel (Mr. Hooper) cross-examined Witness Rajesh Neupane from 11:43 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in open session. This concluded his testimony.
- e. Defence Co-Counsel (Mr. Hooper) informed the Chamber he had met with the Prosecution the preceding day and that there were two issues of concern. He explained that the over-redaction of Prosecution witness statements made them incomprehensible. He added that the Prosecution was looking in that matter. Defence Co-Counsel (Mr. Hooper) also expressed his concerns regarding an African Rights document that was part of the Prosecution Pre-Trial Brief. He indicated that this document was very prejudicial. The Prosecution indicated that the African Rights document was not in the exhibits bundle but that nevertheless it was part of the Pre-Trial Brief. The Chamber noted this could be a potential contentious matter and left it to the parties to raise it.
- f. The proceedings were adjourned to Monday 25 June 2007 at 8:45 a.m.
