1. Remarks/Remarques:

- a. The Defence (Mr. Hooper) completed the cross-examination of Witness BVW (PW12) from 8:54 to 9:57 a.m. in open session. The Prosecution (Mr. Ismail) declined to re-examine the witness and this concluded her testimony.
- b. Prosecution Witness BVV (PW13) entered the courtroom and made the solemn declaration.
- c. The Prosecution (Mr. Wallace) conducted the examination-in-chief of Witness BVV from 10:05 to 10:17 in closed session and until 11:53 a.m. in open session with an adjournment from 11:03 to 11:31 a.m.
- d. The Defence (Mr. Hooper) conducted the cross-examination of the witness from 11:55 a.m. to 12:43 p.m. in closed session and from 12:43 to 2:58 p.m. in open session with a break from 1:01 to 2:49 p.m. The Defence also conducted the cross-examination of the witness in closed session from 2:58 to 3:39 p.m. and from 4:42 to 5:02 p.m. with a part from 3:39 to 4:42 p.m. in open session.
- e. The Prosecution (Mr. Wallace) re-examined Witness BVV from 5:02 to 5:04 p.m. in closed session. The Bench questioned the witness and after that his testimony was concluded.
- f. Before the lunch break, the Prosecution (Mr. Wallace) raised the issue of the presence of the Defence investigator in the courtroom. The Defence (Mr. Hooper) informed the Chamber that for the moment he had asked the Defence's investigator to leave the courtroom
- g. From 2:59 p.m. the Chamber sat pursuant to Rule 15bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence as Judge Arrey was absent for health reasons.
- h. The proceedings were adjourned to Thursday 24 January 2008 at 8:45 a.m. in courtroom IV.
