1. Remarks/Remarques:

- a. The Chamber sat pursuant to Rule 15bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence in the absence of Judge Arrey from 8:50 to 10:25 a.m. Then the Chamber sat as a full bench.
- b. The Prosecution (Mr. Ntukamazina) examined Prosecution Witness BSV (PW 15) in closed session from 8:53 to 9:30 a.m. and until 12:00 p.m. in open session with adjournments from 10:25 to 10:27 a.m. and from 11:00 to 11:45 a.m.
- c. The Defence (Mr. Hooper) requested the Chamber to postpone the cross-examination of Witness BSV due to some new elements that appeared during the examination-in-chief and the need to consult with the Accused. The Prosecution did not object but indicated that it was not in a position to commence the examination of the next witness. (See the ruling of the Chamber at paragraph 2.a).
- d. The Presiding Judge asked the Prosecution who were the remaining Prosecution witnesses. The Prosecution (Mr. Kapaya) informed the Chamber that they were CBC, CAZ, CAP, CAS, CBB and BXM.
- e. The Defence (Mr. Hooper) requested from the Chamber the authorization for his client to stay in the courtroom instead of being taken immediately back to UNDF in order to discuss the case. (See the Chamber's ruling at paragraph 2.b).
- f. The proceedings were adjourned to Monday 28 January 2008 at 8:45 a.m. in courtroom IV.
