TRIAL DAY 17

1. Remarks/Remarques:

- a. The Defence (Mr. Hooper) cross-examined Prosecution Witness BSV (PW15) from 8:55 to 9:16 a.m. in closed session and until 1:03 p.m. in open session with an adjournment from 11:01 to 11:39 a.m. The Prosecution (Mr. Ntukamazina) re-examined the witness from 2:50 to 2:59 p.m. The Bench questioned the witness and then his testimony was concluded.
- b. While waiting for the appearance of the next witness, the parties discussed the sequence of the remaining Prosecution witnesses. The Prosecution (Mr. Kapaya) informed the Chamber that the sequencing of the witnesses was as follows: Witnesses CBC, CAZ, CAP, BXM, CAS and CBB. He stated that he intended to call witnesses CAS and CBB to testify on 8 February 2008. The Defence (Mr. Altit) asked the Prosecution to indicate the expected date for the end of the presentation of the Prosecution case. Mr. Kapaya stated that the Prosecution case would go through 8 February 2008. The Prosecution (Mr. Wallace) informed the Chamber that it just received communication of a voluminous document in Kinyarwanda that the Defence intended to use during the cross-examination of the next Prosecution witness, CBC, and it requested the Chamber to give it enough time for preparation.
- c. Prosecution Witness CBC (PW16) entered the courtroom and made the solemn declaration.
- d. The Prosecution (Mr. Wallace) examined Witness CBC from 3:50 to 3:58 p.m. in closed session and continued until 5:01 p.m. in open session.
- e. The proceedings were adjourned to Tuesday 29 January 2008 at 8:45 a.m. in courtroom IV when the Prosecution would continue the examination-in-chief of Prosecution Witness CBC.
