I. Remarks/Remarques:

- a. The Prosecution (Mr. Wallace) completed the examination-in-chief of Prosecution Witness CBC (PW 16) from 8:57 to 9:14 a.m. in open session.
- b. The Defence (Mr. Hooper) conducted the cross-examination of the witness from 9:15 to 9:58 a.m. in open session, and until 10:26 a.m. in closed session. Then it completed the cross-examination of the witness from 10:27 a.m. to 3:12 p.m. in open session with adjournments from 10:59 to 11:36 a.m. and from 1:06 to 3:05 p.m. Then the Prosecution (Mr. Wallace) requested the Chamber to give him more time to be familiarized with the documents used by the Defence during the cross-examination of the witness and informed the Chamber that he intended to re-examine the witness later. After some questions by the Bench, the Presiding Judge informed the witness that his testimony would continue the following day at 8:45 a.m. with the Prosecution re-examination.
- c. Prosecution Witness CAZ (PW17) entered the courtroom and made the solemn declaration.
- d. The Prosecution (Mr. Ntukamazina) examined Witness CAZ from 3:06 to 3:41 p.m. in closed session and until 5:03 p.m. in open session.
- e. The Presiding Judge informed the parties that the next day the Chamber would sit in courtroom Laity Kama for the re-examination of Witness CBC (PW16) and the cross-examination of Witness CAZ (PW17).
- f. The proceedings were adjourned to Wednesday 30 January 2008 at 8:45 a.m. in courtroom Laity Kama.
